Awards

Each dog passing Coursing Ability Test will be offered an orange qualifying ribbon.
Each dog passing FAST CAT will be offered a light blue ribbon.
Dog must cross the finish line.

Tests offered and Other Important Information

Two separate tests are being offered each day. The second test will begin no sooner than 30 minutes after the conclusion of the first test. You may use a single entry form per dog to enter one or all of the tests by circling the information on the entry form. Each test requires a \$20 entry fee for pre-entered dogs. Late entries and day of entries \$30. conditional entries will not be accepted.

Inspection for each test starts 1/2 hour prior to roll call for the first test each day. Dogs entered in only the second test may check in at any time prior to or at roll call for second test. Any dog not present at the roll call time for a test will be scratched. Coursing for the first test will start as soon as dogs are check in.

Electronic timers will be used

A powered continuous loop system will be used with white or colored plastic streamers and/or for the lure.

Be sure your dog can be caught at the end of the course.

Coursing Ability Test: Open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Dogs with breed disqualifications and spayed neutered dogs are eligible to participate. NO BITCHES IN SEASON. A dog may enter only once per event—defined by an event number.

600 yards or 300 yards (for dogs shorter than 12 inches and/or brachycephalic) Veterans (age 7 or over on the date of the trial) may run 2/3s of the normal course distance. Length must be designated on entry form.

Fast CAT: Open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Dogs with breed disqualifications and spayed neutered dogs are eligible to participate. NO BITCHES IN SEASON. A dog may enter only once per event—defined by an event number.

The Test Committee reserves the right to bar known aggressive dogs. The Test Committee reserves the right to alter the track as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the test.

A penalty of \$5.00 will be assessed for any loose dog not competing while the test is in progress.
